The book starts off with a few letters our main character Becky receives from the bank. Saying that she needs to contact the bank managers assistant as her bill is skyrocketing.

You can tell when you read the letters that Becky has managed to make-up excuses for not calling the assistant. For instance 'she broke her leg'.
