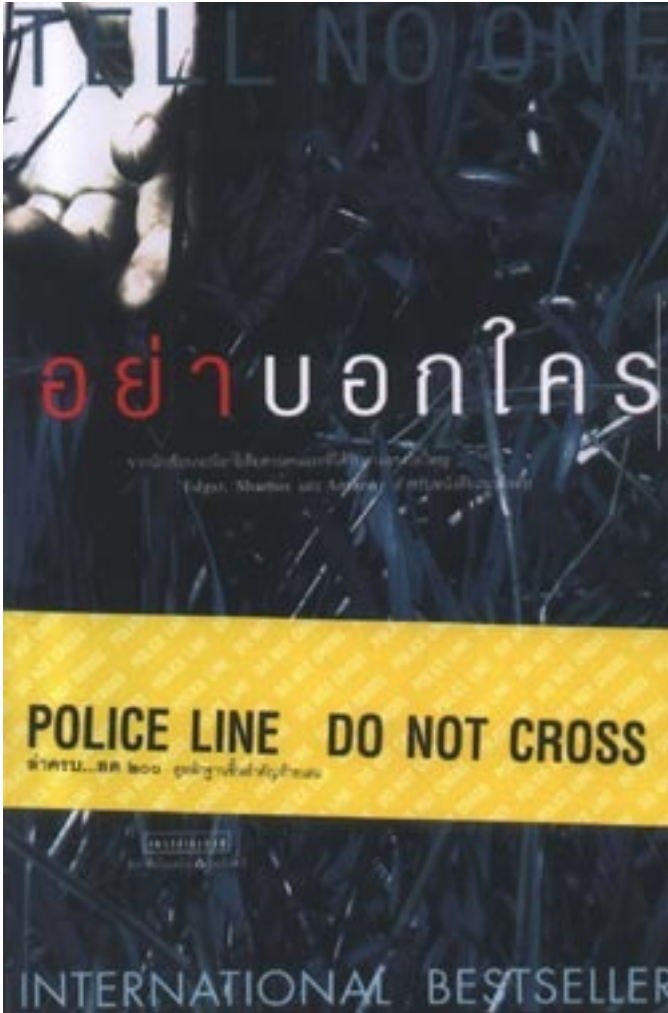

If I have been one of many guys, i'd have acknowledged or requested issues that he did not. His silence allowed a fascinating twist to be published a couple of minutes later. It used to be handy for the author, no longer logical for the reader. 3. i admire twists and surprises however the major twist used to be not easy to believe. A loving couple saved secrets and techniques from every one other, which have been the type of secrets and techniques a loving couple wouldn't hold from each one other. yet that used to be the foundation for the book. The total result's a good secret story. yet my difficulties have been associated with characters' activities no longer becoming their motivations. Um dia, recebe um electronic mail misterioso com informações que só ele e Elizabeth poderiam saber e passa a desconfiar que ela possa estar viva. Nesse mesmo período, dois corpos, que podem estar ligados ao assassinato, aparecem e tudo o que se sabia pode mudar. E agora, ela está viva? Ele está delirando? Com quem ele pode contar? Em quem confiar? Ficamos cheios de porquês e querendo descobrir todo o mistério em questão. Tem quem descubra tudo emblem de cara, mas não sou dessas. Até elaboro teorias, penso em possibilidades, acerto alguma coisa, mas tudo muito vago. Para quem mata a charada rapidinho, não sei se é um livro interessante, pois a graça está só, e somente só, no desenrolar dos fatos. A escrita é bem pobre e isso me surpreendeu bastante, dada a fama do autor. Ele sabe contar a história, sabe deixar os ganchos no ultimate de cada capítulo, sabe como prender o leitor, mas é só.
