Matthew Gatheringwater: I picked up [A Shilling for Candles](#) because *Young and Innocent*, one of my favorite early Hitchcock films, is based on it. I was surprised to realize, however, that the film is only very loosely adapted from the book, Hitchcock having lifted a single idea from the plot: a man, who may or may not be innocent, is a fugitive from the law and finds assistance from a young woman who may or may not be in love with him. People who've watched the film shouldn't have their experience of the book spoiled, since [A Shilling for Candles](#) is full of twists and even the solution to the mystery is different to that which ends the film. Both are good fun for people who like classic British mysteries.

Clare: This was another very good book by Josephine Tey. She surprised me by not having this book be similar to the other- I've noticed that most mystery books that are in a series, where they are solved by the same person, tend to have a formula as to how the book goes... it opens with the death set up, then they go to the home of the Investigator/ or the police-station, or wherever- then to the victim to look them over... whatever.
