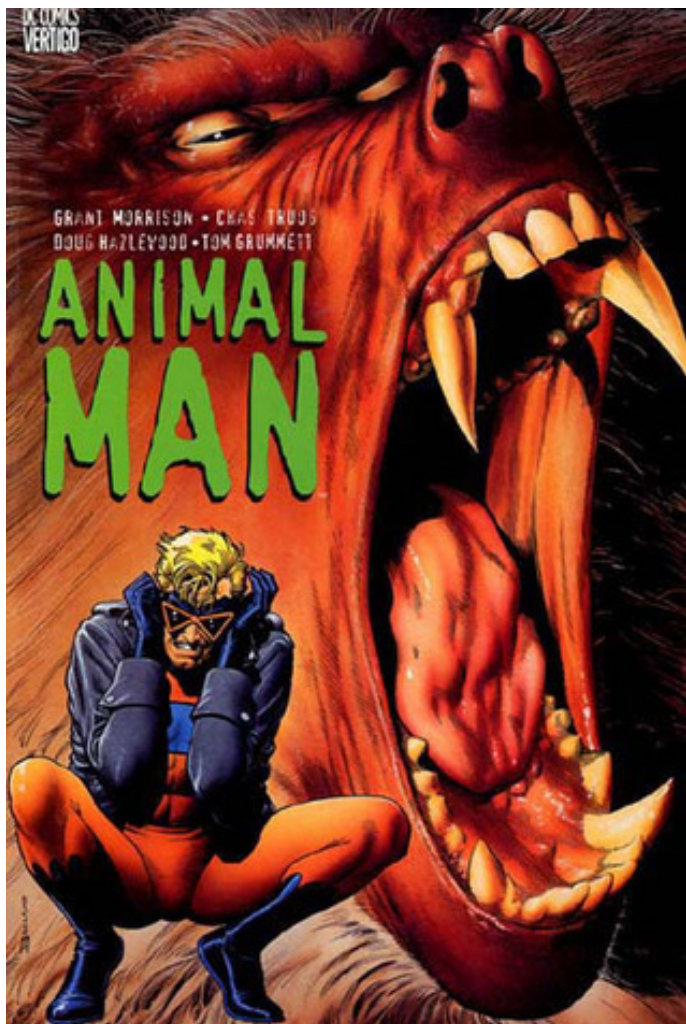

Jace: Is the concept a straightforward superhero story from Grant Morrison too good to be true? Maybe in this day and age, but not back in the 80s. That's one of the things I liked most about this volume: it's a collection of 9 serialized and self-contained stories, free of the pretentious meta-textualism and the masturbatory self-reference that has plagued most of Morrison's recent work. Plus, unlike his work on Batman, you don't need to know every villain from the last 60 years of Animal Man's history in order to understand the plotline. [Rather than turn this into a "Why I hate Grant Morrison" forum thread, I'm just gonna stop with the criticism.:]

The characterization is great. Instead of a millionaire playboy or a cosmopolitan reporter, Buddy Baker is just an average middle-class guy with a wife and 2 kids. In fact, he can be quite a loser at times. He's a sympathetic character, who doesn't understand the extent of his powers anymore than he understands how Blue Beetle made it onto the Justice League. Some people might find this a negative, but I really enjoy the notion of a socially-conscious, environmentally aware superhero, especially one more subtle and conflicted than Captain Planet.

On the other hand, nothing about this book really stands out. I like the character, but so far it's pretty generic comic book fare. And I was disappointed when I finally read the much-heralded "Coyote Gospel" issue. I'm not sure what the big fanfare is all about. Personally, it was a little too cute & clever (without actually saying anything) and underscores my aforementioned complaint with Grant Morrison. Also, whoever assembled the graphic novels could have separated them differently. This collection ends abruptly with issue 9 and doesn't leave the reader with much incentive to pick up the next volume. Because the first 36 issues come so highly recommended, I'm most likely going to end up checking them out.

Justyn Rampa: This volume collects the first 9 issues of Grant Morrison's run on Animal Man which has been heralded as something truly wonderful.

I don't completely agree, but I can see where they are coming from.

Originally published in 1988 1989, these issues I think began to introduce the world to the madness of Grant Morrison as well as the animal activism of Grant Morrison.

As for the animal activism, I feel like Grant Morrison did that best with We3. As for his madness,

I think Grant Morrison has aged well, growing into his madness like a true genius. Admittedly, he alerts the reader of this particular volume that some of the story lines will not make sense due to the lack of context for larger comic book arcs going on at that time. It's true. The series itself, was engaging enough to keep me reading but also because I made a promise to my comic book guy.

The true gem of the volume and indeed one of the most adored issues of all time is "The Coyote Gospel". Grant Morrison addresses it in the intro, my comic book guy said it is one of his favorite stories of all time. I can see the challenge and the appeal it presents.

I think that is all I will say.

It requires a re-read because I can't really formulate my thoughts although my initial impression is that it is brilliant!

Zedsdead: Man, I thought this was supposed to be some kind of astute subversion of 80s superhero comics, but it felt pretty much like every other insipidly-dialogued mainstream superhero story, with a bunch of cheesy cameos shoehorned in to sell issues. I could almost hear the live studio audience squealing with glee whenever Hawkman or Martian Manhunter made a fawning full-frame appearance. Disappointing.
