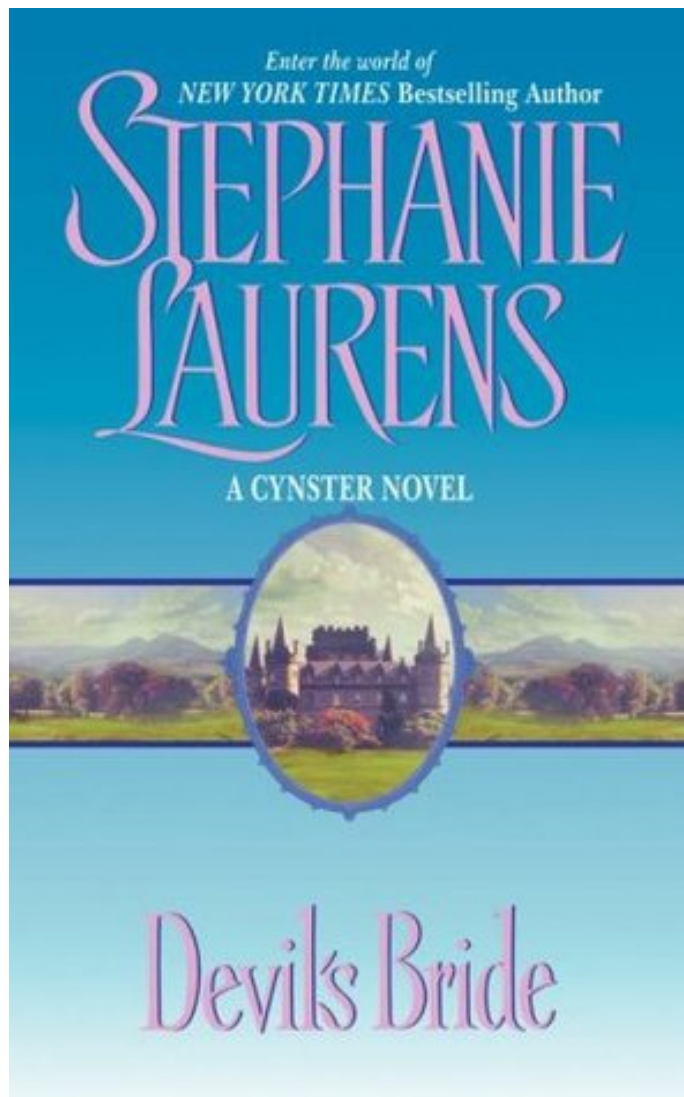

I was a little disappointed with the lack of plot in this book and the "mystery" could have been handled better (or at all). Instead it was: make-out, slip in the tiniest crumb of information about what Devil was doing to solve the murder but not enough to actually tell you anything worthwhile, sex scene, repeat. I don't mind when a book focuses on the physical aspects of the character's relationship but this was starting to feel like the same scene, different bedroom. There was so much repetition in both the plot and the thoughts of the characters that it seemed completely unnecessary and slowed things down way too much. I actually started to skim through what should have been the juicy parts to try and find some substance or actual story! Unfortunately all I got was this:

"Devil stirred as the last candle guttered. Even before he lifted his head, he'd assimilated the fact that there was a woman, sleeping the sleep of the sated, more or less beneath him. Before he levered his shoulders away from her and looked down, he'd recalled who that woman was." Wow, isn't he a bright one! He knew who it was he'd *just had sex with* without even having to get off of her and take a look (and no, he wasn't drunk)!!! What, does he have short term memory loss? Within the time it takes for a candle to burn down, he almost forgot who the hell the woman in his bed was!?! That gives new meaning to "mind blowing sex"; apparently he blew more than just his load which would actually explain a great deal of the rest of the book! :D

The part that disappointed me the most was with Honoria's estranged grandfather. Devil went to go see him but, not only were we not invited to join him, we were barely even told about it! That visit and the reunion with Honoria should have been a pivotal part of the book but instead it was given only a few lines! Why? So we could hear Honoria wax poetic about her husband's chest a little more!?! Or how about the scene where Devil finds out who it was that was frequenting the freaky brothel - oh wait, we missed that scene too but I think there was a line about it somewhere...

Not a bad book overall for a fluff read, but there was far too much focus on the fluff for my liking! I would've liked to know how the characters interacted and what they were doing *outside* of the bedroom a little more. I also would've liked a chance to get to know some of the other Cynster's better. That's my favourite part of a series like this - the build up and development of the rest of the characters so by the time you get to their story you have a vested interest in their lives and happiness plus you get little updates on how the previous couples are doing. This book skipped the building up and development part. I can't actually even remember most of their names, who was who, who did what, etc. I'll read the next book and see how it goes (especially since the book I own is the first 2 in one volume) but if it's more of the same, all fluff and no substance, I'll probably move on to something else. I've still got Kleypas, Quinn, Balogh, Lindsey...
