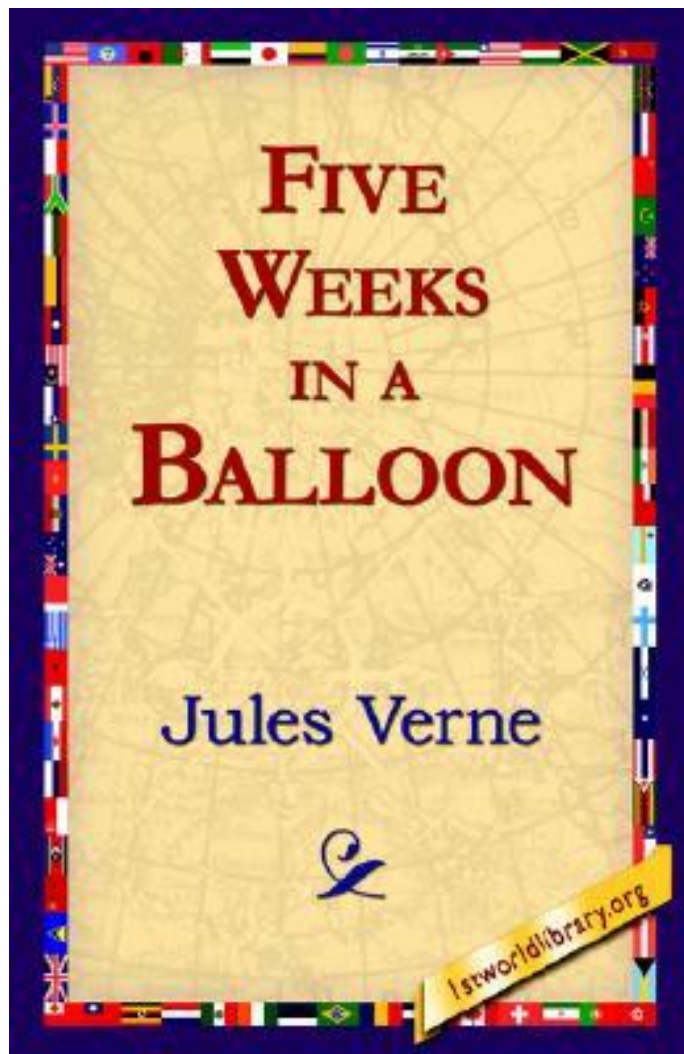

There was a large audience assembled on the 14th of January, 1862, at the session of the Royal Geographical Society, No. 3 Waterloo Place, London. The president, Sir Francis M -, made an important communication to his colleagues, in an address that was frequently interrupted by applause. This rare specimen of eloquence terminated with the following sonorous phrases bubbling over with patriotism: "England has always marched at the head of nations" (for, the reader will observe, the nations always march at the head of each other), "by the intrepidity of her explorers in the line of geographical discovery." Miro: Pametni Englez, njegov odani sluga i snažni Škot u avanturi života. Zanimljiva je ovo knjiga sa sredine 19. stoljeća koja svjedoči na (upitno) relativno benigni način u odnosu Europe prema Africi dok je još bila srce tame. Na tom istraživačkom pohodu kroz mnoge afričke predjele, dok se ne bavi objašnjavanjem funkcioniranja i manevriranja balona, narator daje (navodno)(tada znane) iscrpne podatke glede geografije, ekosustava i društva. Nema pretjeranih iznenađenja kod samog tijeka radnje; radi se o vrlo jednostavnoj dramskoj strukturi: uvod, zaplet, kraj, uz mnoge nedaće nad kojima narator uvijek ima kontrolu. Rasizam je u *Balonu* očekivano prisutan (mada bih se usudio reći ne u mjeri u kojoj bi mogao biti), kao i idealiziranje imperijalističke i kolonijalne britanske velesile, a zbog toga bi roman možda bio korisniji teoretičarima nego uživateljima književnosti. Za potonju bi skupinu, pak, možda bila prigodnija djela poput *20.000 milja pod morem*, *Tajanstveni otok* ili *Put oko svijeta za 80 dana*.

Sure, it had its problems. The plot was a bit formulaic, and the characters weren't all that deep and fleshed out.

But it was fun, and entertaining.

Don't be put off by comments of racist language, although that is certainly scattered throughout the book. But this book was also published in 1862, and so is a product of its times, and you have to take that into account when reading it.
