Manon-Marie: Voilà un livre qui a bercé mon enfance et sur lequel j'ai appris à lire ! Et même si maintenant je suis beaucoup plus âgée, c'est toujours avec plaisir et nostalgie que je me replonge dans les (més)aventures de la jeune et espiègle héroïne de la Comtesse de Ségur. Sophie est une petite fille choyée et espiègle avec une imagination pour le moins débordante. Elle n'hésite pas à entraîner son cousin Paul et ses amies Camille et Madeleine (les fameuses petites filles modèles) dans ses aventures et ses bêtises.

Pour moi, relire ce livre c'est retomber en enfance et se rappeler toutes les émotions et les comportements qui sont rattachés à cette période. La petite Sophie est une enfant vraiment attachante malgré tous ses défauts et les bêtises qu'elle s'ingénie à imaginer. Que ce soit avec sa poupée ou des poissons rouges, Sophie de Réan, n'est jamais à court d'idées pour passer le temps. Dommage que la plupart du temps ses inventions se terminent mal. Il faut dire que sa mère a fort à faire pour inculquer des valeurs à Sophie et lui apprendre à obéir. Et dommage aussi pour son cousin Paul, bien souvent victime des idées loufoques de sa petite cousine. Mais heureusement ces deux-là s'adorent et sont inséparables.

Les livres de la Comtesse de Ségur se veulent éducatifs. Chaque chapitre, à travers le comportement et les bêtises de nos petits héros, transmet une leçon de vie au lecteur. Si ces leçons de vie sont assez moralisatrices et pleines de piété, il ne faut pas oublier que ce livre a été écrit sous le Second Empire, à une époque où la religion était partie intégrante de la vie courante.

L'écriture de la Comtesse de Ségur est fluide et aérée même si le langage utilisé est soutenu. Cela ne l'empêche pas d'être parfaitement compréhensible et adapté aux plus jeunes, les écrits de la Comtesse de Ségur étant à l'origine destinés à ses petits-enfants.

Je t'assure que je ne crois à aucune mauvaise motion de ta part, et tu n'as pas besoin de me regarder d'un air si farouche.", this means that "How you get angry! It used to be a jest I made. I guarantee you that i don't think in any wrongdoing in your part, and also you should not have to examine me with the sort of wild air." -- Now, both we've turn into unbelievably dimwitted now within the twenty first century, and proper me if i am wrong, yet sons and daughters don't speak like that. Three-year-olds are typically slightly intelligible, and five-year-olds may well speak well, yet now not eloquently. \*The quantity of chores performed via the masters of the house; M. et Mme de Réan are in actual fact prosperous those who dwell in a fortress filled with servants, but Mme de Réan usually takes on tasks that you'd imagine will be left to the servants, like feeding the horses.
