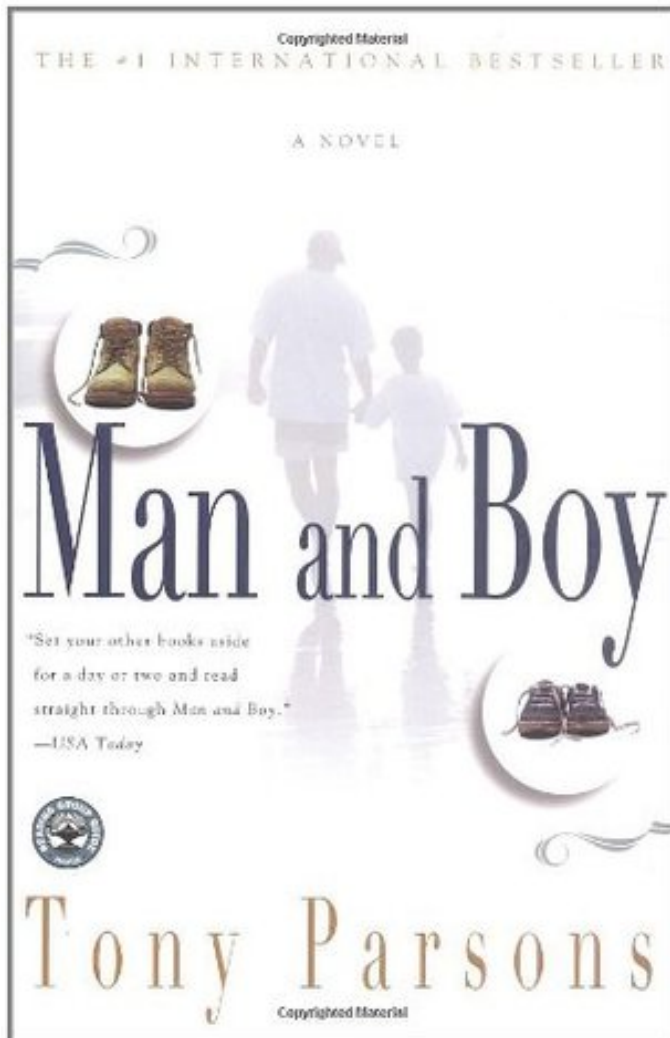

Tony Parsons authentically captures all the nuances of man's relationship with his aging father. It was the most believable portrayal I've ever read, and let me tell you, I've read a lot of them.
