-Karen-: I was about to be rather snippy and say that this is a medicine best taken in younger years, at a time of life when foreshadowing laid on with a trowel feels less obviously manipulative, when characters painted in primaries are still fresh and new, when drama is still drama and not melodrama. but then I fell to thinking about that phrase, *laid on with a trowel*, and how it comes from bricklaying, denoting the rather heavy, slapdash way of laying the mortar on to a brick. It indicates a lack of finesse. But that is how it is done. How it has to be done. For a good strong wall to be built.

Stark, simple, straight. True.
Those are not bad qualities.

And the sense of loneliness.

It may not be subtle, but it catches the heart.

However, I was tortured using the much duller implement that is *Pride and Prejudice* by Jane Austen. Now I know this is traditionally regarded as an off-the-scale literary achievement of sublime amazingness (at least my mother thinks so) but as I still have a few pages and possibly a bit of the cover jammed between my molars from the way in which it was forced down my throat I would beg to differ. When asked to comment on "Jane Austen's witty use of irony" I would frequently comment that what I found most ironic about the book was the fact that the Industrial Revolution, the most significant technological event since man created fire was occurring at the time she was writing and she failed to make mention of it even once. Big

mistake Jane. Big.

Anyhoo, back to *Of Mice and Men*. I liked it. Paul Bryant: The identify of this novel is simply 50% accurate, a truly bad effort. Yes, it's approximately mice, yet there's little or not anything approximately mice in those pages. *Mice* fans will come away disappointed. In any such brief book, it is simple to get the characters very wrong... both they're caricatures, or they're cliches or they only simple stink and are boring. i actually felt like I understood those characters, no matter if i did not like them. on the finish of the book, whilst Lennie asks George to yell at him, isn't really he going to hit him, isn't really he going to inform him he'd be at an advantage with out him, i discovered that

simply heartbreaking... that Lennie's feel of normalcy stems from George's frustration with him. I felt for George too. He merely desires to look after Lennie, yet occasionally it is so hard. He cannot be far and wide at once, and has needed to make such a lot of sacrifices so that it will retain Lennie out of the type of hassle that simply comes from no longer realizing any better. This tale is simply a smidge over a hundred pages long, so it will not take you lengthy to learn at all, and that i hugely suggest it. otherwise you might take approximately three 0.5 hours and permit Gary Sinise learn it to you, that's what I did.
