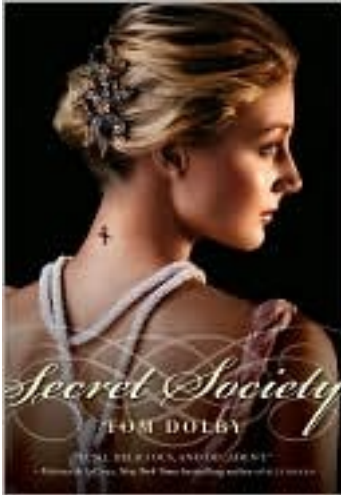

Emeebee: Short version: I didn't like this book. If you want a great YA book with similar elements - prep school and secret societies - pick up *The Disreputable History of Frankie Landau-Banks* by E. Lockhart.

Long version: As far as I could tell prior to opening this book it had everything going for it. I love me some New York City socialites, exclusive prep schools, and Secret Societies... I couldn't see how I wouldn't like this book.

But it was awful.

The writing wore me down and about halfway through (I made it to page 152) I had lost track of what the plot was. It seemed like 4 teenagers thinking "I've got this great opportunity! But did I earn it?" And each of them were thinking this, page after page after page of this awful, shallow, thin thought spiral.

The story is told from four different character's perspectives which made things hard to follow and confusing. And also frustrating because, apart from Patch, they could have all been rolled into one character they were so lacking in unique personality. And Patch only needed to be different for plot reasons. Even his personality was lacking. And for the most part, they all seemed thin and frail. They had little backstory, no personality, and no thoughts beyond "I am sad because I don't think my friend will do what I ask of him even though I won't tell him why." It was vague and not at all vivid. I cannot stress enough how frustrated I was with the characters. They were all hoping to do great things but seemed far more consumed by doubts and double thinking and overthinking. Which I can relate to, sure, but the way it was approached was simply agonizing.

of the book that it was kind of boring, but at some point it got me and I enjoyed the final parts where you finally understand what the book is about.

The writing was great, the story was told from four different points of view. But, it could be kind of confusing sometimes. The characters were not the best, hard to relate. The plot didn't have what I would call rhythm, it was tedious sometimes. But if you like to read about fashion and socialites this a good read for you.

The cover is really appealing, I like it and I like the tattoo. We all have an idea of Secret Societies and it was fun to read about it. If you are a Melissa de la Cruz fan, this book is for you.

The most interesting part was seeing how the perks of belonging to this society helped each of the students and the cost this help comes at.
