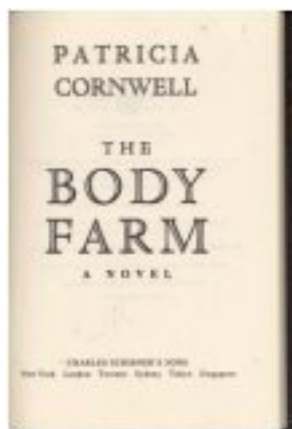

Cheryl: I think I've watched too much CSI because I had the culprit pegged very early in the book. I still enjoyed it, but it would have been better I'm sure if I'd read the previous books in the series. A problem with this story is the stereotypical way the locals are portrayed. Being a local living in western North Carolina, I feel slightly offended by the insinuations about clueless local cops, mentally challenged mountain dwellers, and other stock character elements. Thank heaven this gal from the big city came here and saved the day. One other problem I have with it is the lack of resolution of major case elements. What exactly does Gault have to do with the Eye Spy shop? Why was the cop killed and why in such a way? To discredit him? To frame him? To keep him from solving the case? What about the SIDs death? How did the husband really die? Will the heroine wind up with man she loves? I need more closure.

I can see why this character was something new and refreshing when she debuted. Scarpetta comes across as a bit entitled and full of herself, which threw me off at times. She is not quite like any other female character I have read. But there is something satisfying in listening to her take care of business #bossbitch style, and the plot was compelling enough to keep me going.

The dynamics between Scarpetta and different characters really help elevate this above other murder mysteries. The way she serves as a mother figure to her niece is heartwarming, and [\(view spoiler\)](#). Dealing with forensics and medical examinations, the book can get graphic but neither the gore or jargon is overwhelming. Instead most of it provides a "oh hey that's neat, I didn't know that" sort of trivia regarding criminal investigations.

In addition to being a little put off by Scarpetta's personality, I also found the narrator (C.J. Critt) to be a off-putting as well. Her reading isn't objectively bad in any way; I think what doesn't click for me is how emotionally distant she sounded, particularly since it is first person perspective. I realize Scarpetta is supposed to be one cool cucumber, but at moments of great personal distress I didn't think the reading conveyed the impact of how a person would be feeling. BUT Critt is skilled at doing male voices, I LOVED her voice for Pete Marino as well as the various secondary characters that popped in and out of the novel.

I know a few different narrators have performed the Scarpetta series, so it would be interesting to compare and contrast different reading styles.
