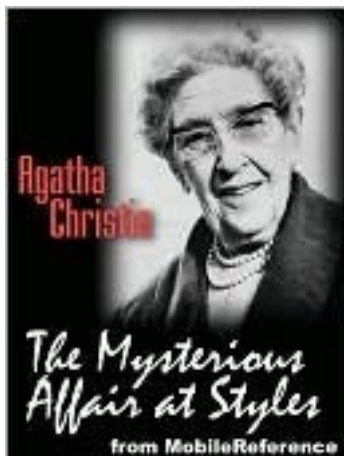

Laurel Young: Thus begins My Year of Agatha! Over the course of 2010, I'll be reading all of Dame Agatha Christie's canon, more or less in order of publication. I've read most if not all of them before, but in some cases it has been many years. I'm most familiar with her Golden Age work (1920-1939), because the study of it formed the second chapter of my doctoral dissertation. The chapter has already been published, and so my Year of Agatha is purely for personal pleasure. She is my favorite of all mystery authors, and a source of endless delight.

Re-reading her first novel, I was struck by the way this perfect mystery sprang upon the world fully-formed like Athena from the mind of Zeus! ALL of Dame Agatha's trademarks are here: the double-twist ending, carried off with perfect confidence, the fully-fledged characters of Poirot and son cher ami Hastings with all their quirks, the clues hidden among domestic detail red herrings. As always, she "plays fair"--it is not her fault that hardly anyone, today, will know what "spills" (as a noun, not a verb) were in 1920, making the crime even harder to solve.

The Mysterious Affair at Styles marked the dawn of the Golden Age of mystery in Great Britain. Young Agatha, with time on her hands during her chemist's dispensary job during WWI, put her new knowledge of poisons to work by trying her hand at a murder mystery...and a star was born! :)

Stela: To say that Doyle and Christie are mystery masters is almost a truism, since you find in their novels all ingredients to sustain this affirmation: perfect plot, charming weird detective, exquisite writing, interesting characters.

So it's no wonder that for me, a successful detective story has somehow to fall into a pattern they established a long time ago: clues gathered by a sharp mind, apparent contradictions and /or mistakes, dramatic turn of events and of course the big finale: the last reunion, where all the masks fall and the truth is revealed in a dramatic summary of the facts, that is to say where all the i's are dotted and all the t's are crossed.

And in Agatha Christie's case, the tension of the story is increased by the ambivalent attitude of the narrator, who forever hesitates to trust the detective with the power to find the truth. In fact, I think the couple Hastings-Poirot is even more colourful than Watson-Holmes, especially because of the doubts the captain freely expresses all along the story together with his own innocent interpretation of the events. His delightful naive opinions value as much as Poirot's smart reasoning, conducting to false paths and strange conclusions.

Besides, the discovery of the criminal is always satisfactory for the reader - in this first Hercule Poirot novel, for example, I thought I knew who the murderer was, then I dismissed my suspicion as too evident, to find I had been right all along, but not for the empiric reasons I first formulated. But, boy, did I have fun!

Therefore, whenever in search for a light but good reading, Agatha Christie is always a very good choice.
