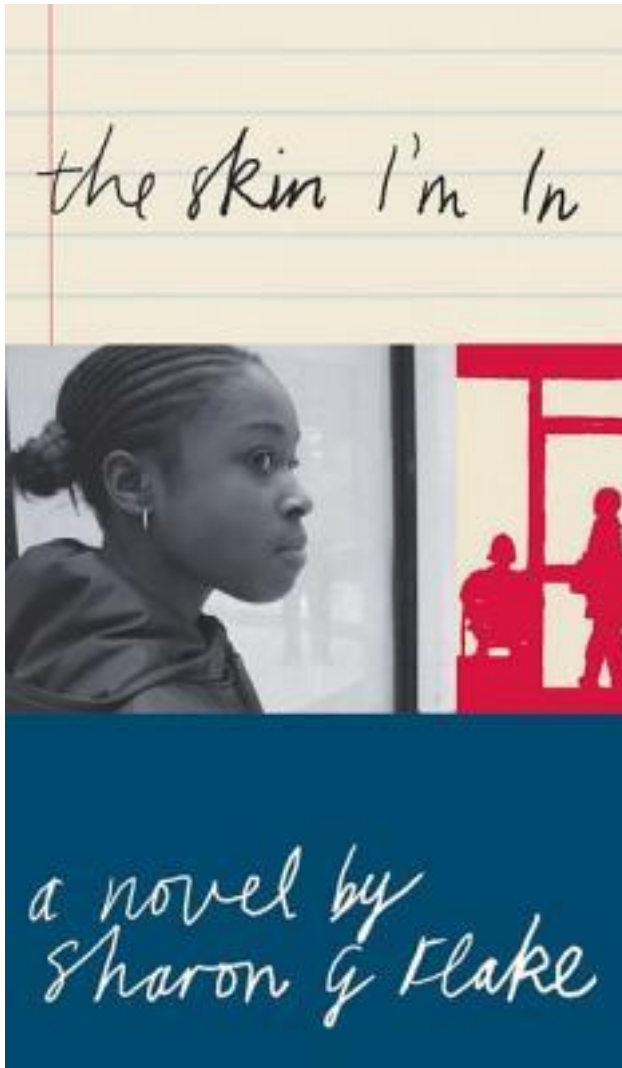

Char tricks Maleeka into lighting the room on fire and runs away, leaving poor Maleeka to get caught. Maleeka takes the blame at first, but then ends up telling on Char. In the end, Maleeka and Caleb are back together and Maleeka is friends with Miss Saunders. At the end of the book Maleeka says "I may be black and I may be ugly, but I love the skin I'm in and no one can ever change that". I think that this statement teaches a valuable lesson. The lesson is that you shouldn't get too caught up in what other people think of your appearance because they are wasting their lives "hating" on you while you are focused on making your life better. I would recommend this to students all over the world because it can teach them a very valuable lesson. I would also recommend this book to teachers that have ever been picked on.
