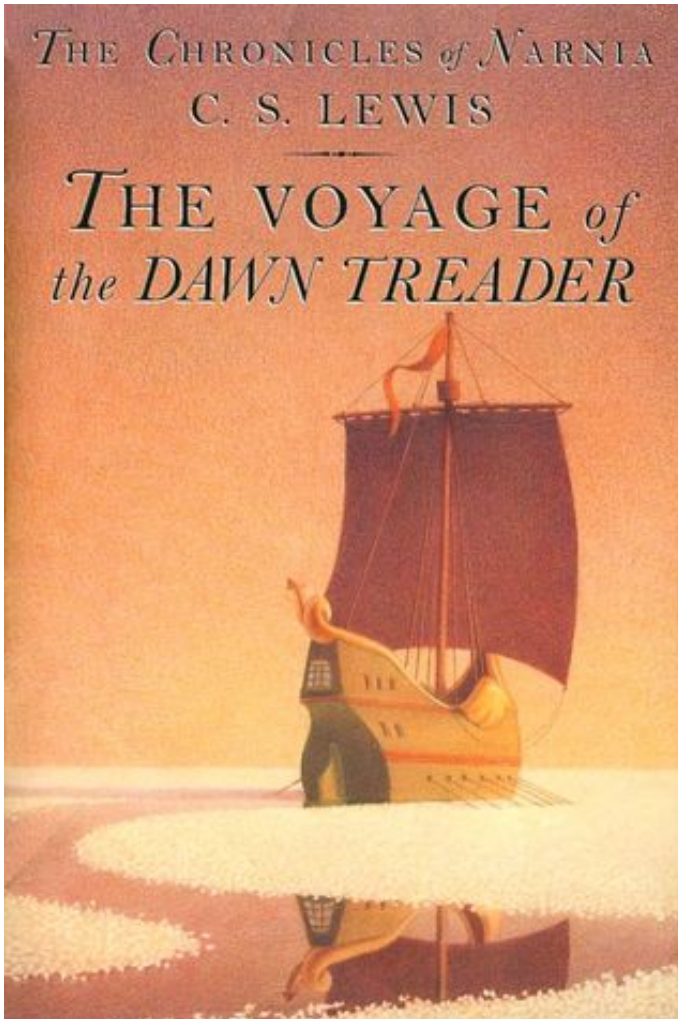

And so, Edmund, Lucy and a much less enthusiastic Eustace turn into entangled during this global spanning journey. And what awesome adventures follow! Soon, the 3 childrens locate

themselves cruising from island to island, rediscovering historical Narnians, encountering dragons and sea serpents, operating afoul of magic after magic, and locate themselves replaced via all that they see and face.
